
I FAGIOLINI'S GOOSED! — PREMIERE BOXING DAY 2022

Clouseau meets Cluedo in GOOSED!

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Vocal ensemble I Fagiolini's latest short music film released free-to-view at 3pm, BOXING DAY, 2022.

- Based on Giovanni Croce's Venetian masque, IL GIOCA DELL'OCA The Game of the Goose (1595) - this short farce continues I Fagiolini's award-winning film tradition and mission to make music accessible for broader audiences. 3pm on Boxing Day is the perfect time for a board game in the 'drawing room'!
- Published by Giovanni Croce in Venice, 1595, the masque shows six characters playing the Game of The Goose a board game still popular in much of Europe. The film features a print of a 1598 Italian version from the British Library.
- The 10 minute film, written by Timothy Knapman and shot by Robert Hollingworth and Gregory Browning's *Polyphonic Films*, sets the action as a farce set in a 1930s English manor house, complete with inept coppers and a scheming thief.
- GOOSED! follows the group's notable film successes, most recently John La Bouchardière's THE STAG HUNT – winner of European Early Music Network *REMA's award for <u>Audience</u> Engagement / Best Music Film of 2022*.

- Filming took place in April 2022 at the beautiful Hawkwood College in Stroud, Gloucestershire, with Video Direction by Gregory Browning and Director of Photography Xavier Amorós.

SYNOPSIS

I Fagiolini star in GOOSED! A forlorn Count is having a soirée at his country seat but is surprised by some uninvited guests. They play the Game of the Goose.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Music director Robert Hollingworth has turned to film once more to bring life to Renaissance music which doesn't fit into a conventional view of 'Masses and Madrigals'. He writes: "I've a soft spot for music with a social function whose context is fascinating but lost today, requiring a more creative approach for it to be 'read' for a contemporary audience. Croce's 'Game of the Goose' is from 'The Musical Cure-All' (Triaca Musicale, 1595). In it six characters play board game still common in much of Europe but fallen out of use in the UK. I Fagiolini performs the piece in concert but with film we can take it further. I hope we'll briefly cheer people up..."

Robert asked Timothy Knapman to create a screenplay for the piece: "Reading its text, I noted various guests jockeying for position around a powerful nobleman, and that love was in the air. I'm a sucker for PG Wodehouse, Cole Porter and the lighter-than-air musicals of the 1920s/30s with their silly toffs, adventuresses and jewel thieves getting up to romantic mischief in country houses. It didn't take much to see that this would fit rather nicely into that world."
